Welcome to Northwest Freeway MUD

Northwest Freeway Municipal Utility District (the "District") was created by Order of the Texas Water Rights Commission, on March 10, 1977. The purpose of its creation was to provide water production and distribution, wastewater collection and treatment and drainage facilities to serve the land within its boundaries. Its creation requires the District to operate under the provisions of Chapter 49 and Chapter 54 of the Texas Water Code, as amended, and other general statutes of Texas applicable to Municipal Utility Districts. The confirmation election for the District was held within the District on April 2, 1977.

The District is located in the Richard Walton Survey, Abstract 845 and the Harris County School Land Survey, Abstract 333. It is approximately 30 miles northwest of Houston's Central Business District and is within the City of Houston's extraterritorial Jurisdiction and the boundaries of the Waller Independent School District. The current size of the District is 399.178 acres. More specifically, the District is located immediately north and west of the Intersection of U.S. Highway 290 and Becker Road, in northwest Harris County. U.S. Highway 290 is adjacent to and south of the District.


Goals of the Election

Initial Infrastructure was installed in late 1970's. On average, infrastructure lasts about 30-40 years.


- District Goals:

- Rehabilitation of the District's drainage ditches and detention

















What is a Bond Authorization?



- A bond authorization is an authorization to sell bonds to fund district projects.
 - *Similar* to a line of credit that a business might use to fund its operations.
- An authorization is **not** immediate funding, nor is it a "blank check" to fund the entire amount of the authorization without meeting strict regulatory requirements.
- While an authorization may be for a large amount, bonds may only be sold once necessary projects are ready to begin or as needed for repairs and maintenance or replacement.

Funding Projects: Bond Authorization vs. "PAY As You Go"

Bond Authorization

"Pay As You Go"

Example: Project cost \$3.6M

- bonds are sold to fund project
- Ad valorem (property tax rate) should not increase
- Average home contribution to project: \$15.50/mo, or approx. \$185/year
- Current and future residents share debt burden over 30 years

Example: Project cost \$3.6M

- resident water bills are funding source
- Water rates increase in advance of project to fund (barring emergency need)
- Average home contribution to project: approx. \$3000 (barring emergency need)
- Debt Burden is immediate and 100% on current residents

In both cases, funding for project must be in the bank prior to bidding project.

Hines Business Park's Financial Impact on Northwest Freeway MUD

If the bond election passes and the Hines business park is developed, it is expected to add significant value to the District's tax base (Hines estimates build out taxable value to be approximately \$100M-\$120M)

The value from development of the Hines Business Park would aid the District's goal of keeping the total tax rate at or below current levels
